

# BANK OF TANZANIA ACADEMY THE POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

It is a pleasure to inform you that you have been selected to pursue a nine (9) months Postgraduate Diploma in Banking Management (PGDBM) programme offered by the Bank of Tanzania Academy The programme will be conducted at the Bank of Tanzania Sub-Head Office in Dar-es-Salaam.

I would like to draw your attention to the following aspects related to this programme:

- a) You are required to appear for registration from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025 starting from 1400 to 1700. Failure to register within the stipulated period will warrant us to offer your chance of admission to another student.
- b) You are strongly advised to attend orientation, which will be conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025 from 1400 to 1700 hours.
- c) The class sessions will officially commence on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025. There will be no room for registration after the commencement of studies.
- d) For registration purposes, you should bring with you all ORIGINAL certificates and three recent passport-sized colored photographs.
- e) During registration, you are required to submit the academic certificates (Certificate of Secondary Education, Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education, Birth Certificate, and Bachelor/Advanced Diploma transcript and certificate) which have been certified as the true copy of the original,
- f) You will be admitted upon receipt of evidence for payment of tuition fees as per the schedule indicated in the joining instructions.

The following are the necessary conditions for admission:

### 1. DECLARATION REGARDING COMPLETION OF THE COURSE

All candidates confirming acceptance of vacancies at the Academy must undertake to complete the course unless required to do otherwise by the Academy. Please, sign the relevant sections of the enclosed form of acceptance of the vacancy and medical certificate. Completed filled forms must be returned to the Academy during Registration.

### 2. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Admission into the Academy is conditional upon a satisfactory medical report being received by the Academy. Students are therefore asked to undergo a medical examination by registered medical practitioners. Use the enclosed form which should be brought with you dully filled and signed.

### REGISTRATION AND COURSE COMMENCEMENT

Registration will start on 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025 and the course will commence on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025. If you cannot report on these dates for any reason, please inform us immediately, otherwise, we shall assume that you have opted not to attend the course and the vacancy will be filled by another candidate.

### THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

- (i) Three passport-sized photographs taken recently for registration
- (ii) National Form Four Certificate and Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education
- (iii) Bachelor's Degree/Advance Diploma Certificate and;
- (iv) Birth Certificate

#### **Please Note:**

- (a) At the time of registration, all certificates must be original (plus certified photocopies).
- (b) A candidate without original certificates will not be registered.
- (c) Submission of forged certificates or any false document is a criminal offense and will be dealt with according to the law.

### I. DISCIPLINE

Students admitted to the Academy are expected to observe and abide by the student's By-Laws of the Academy, Examination Guidelines, or any other lawful orders given by the Principal, lecturers, or any other person in authority.
